
ABOUT THE SCITTELS GTI SCHEME

➔ GTI Roles



The work of a SCITTELS GTI is challenging and rewarding and can encompass a wide range of teaching and support roles in the school.

Across primary phases, roles may include literacy and numeracy coaching, 1 to 1 and small group work, co-teaching with the class teacher, working with disadvantaged pupils, special educational needs support and extra curricular support.



➔ GTI Support



Every SCITTELS GTI will be provided with a personalised, employment based development pathway, supported by a school based GTI Mentor.

The pathway will reflect the GTI's starting knowledge, experience and skills and individual development needs and will include induction, a broad school experience, progress monitoring, the opportunity to develop transferable employment skills and career coaching.

SCITTELS stands for School Centred Initial Teacher Training In East London Schools. We are a consortium of schools within East London who work in close partnership to provide outstanding initial teacher training, leading to the award of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS).

The consortium has a strong commitment to Equal Opportunities. Inclusion is a key feature and strength of our programmes and we are committed to training teachers who will value and build on the linguistic, religious and cultural diversity that children in East London communities bring to school and who in turn, will prepare all children for life in a diverse society.

The SCITTELS School Centred Initial Teacher Training (SCITT) Programme

All of our OUTSTANDING programmes give trainee teachers the opportunity to learn from and alongside experienced classroom practitioners. PGCE from the University of Roehampton is also available.

Centre based training takes place in the lead school, Colegrave Primary School, and is delivered by specialists and experts in their field, such as Local Authority advisors. A carefully planned programme of tasks and assignments enables trainees to put into practice in school, the theory that they have learnt during centre based training.

We also provide a high level of individualised support to our trainees, ensuring that they make rapid and sustained progress and are well prepared for teaching in East London and further afield. The majority of our trainees secure employment as a Newly Qualified Teacher (NQT) in one of our partnership schools at the end of their training.
